Each presentation may involve up to 3 presenters. All presenters must register for the conference. At least one presenter must be a current CNIE member in good standing.

All presenters will be invited to participate in a special issue of the **International Journal of E-learning and Distance Education**.

Submission Guidelines:

- Abstracts should be no more than 250 words.
- Proposals for presentations, workshops, and panel discussions should include a title, brief description, and intended format (e.g., presentation, interactive workshop, panel discussion).
- Submissions must be received by Friday, April 12, 2024.
